Bath House and Laundry Room. Views from most camp sites are remarkable; full view of the Spanish Peaks. Back away from the road and near the Cuchara River. About

8 blocks to the Adagio Conference Center, and easy drive. Two restaurants, market and Bakery lie between this site and Robert's. Tent campers with car on space with picnic table costs \$15.00 per night. RV campers \$23 – \$26 plus tax for 2 people per night. \$5 per extra person.

Mary's RV Park — 1-719-742-3252.

This camping area is very close to the Adagio Conference Center. Lots of trees. Ask for a camp site in the second row which is away from the street. Mary accepts tent campers and has a bath house.

Lathrop State Park is beautiful but students will have to drive a little. 1-719-738-2376

Blue Lake and Bear Lake — There is a considerable drive to get to the Adagio Conference Center from Blue and Bear Lakes, probably a 45 minute drive minimum. Both have camping facilities up in the Spanish Peaks area past Cuchara. These spots have occasionally been unavailable for the early part of June when there has been a heavy snow winter. We had a very heavy snow winter this year. Once in town, students can go to the National Forest Service for open hiking trails.
